ANALYSIS OF ACRONYM AND ABBREVIATION IN DAILY POST OF INSTAGRAM

Abstract:

The purposes of this study are to identify the kinds of acronym and abbreviation in the daily post of Instagram, to find out the processes of making acronym and abbreviation in the daily post of Instagram, and to find out the contribution of analysis of acronym and abbreviation in the daily post of Instagram for teaching Morphology. This study is expected to be a source for the lecturer of Morphology, to teach word formation processes (acronym and abbreviation). This research is qualitative analysis research which analyzes acronym and abbreviation in daily posts of random influencers Instagram accounts, posted from January until August 2020 using Plag's theory (2003). The data of the research were collected by reading, finding, analyzing, listing, and classifying. The results of this research were there were two kinds of the acronym, they were acronym with combining the initial letters and acronym with combining parts of different words. And there were three kinds of abbreviations, they were initialism, shortening, and contraction abbreviation. They could be written in capital and lowercase letter. And the contribution of this research was this research could make students easier to understand acronym and abbreviation by searching any caption of Instagram posts, analyzing and classifying them into acronym and abbreviation, and the last point, applying how to use acronym and abbreviation in their daily caption in social media communication.

1. Introduction

In the digital era, there are so many platforms of social media such as Facebook, Instagram, Path, Twitter, Whatsapp, etc. They have several functions in our life. The first one is to communicate among people. No matter how long the distance, people can communicate with their family, buddies, and so on 24 hours. The second is social media also can be used to deliver important information from the government, artist, influencer, etc. That information can be used in a language that can be understandable for all people.

From the platforms we've mentioned above, Instagram becomes one of the most popular sites in the world. Instagram has 400 million active users per month. Instagram users come from so many circles around the world, such as artists, actors/ actresses, celebrities, influencers, gamer, and so on. They use Instagram in their languages, includes English.

Instagram users like artists, celebrities, influencers, and public figures become the most influential users on Instagram. They can influence their followers through their daily posts. It can be about their habits, their lifestyle, and their language. The way they speak or type a caption in their posts will very pursue people to do the same. And lost of them sometimes make a new word, slang, and shorten word so that people become interested in it.

Lots of Instagram influencers use English in their daily posts and comments. And not infrequently those who like to shorten the English they use. It aims to make the sentences simpler, understandable, and sometimes it can be as their identity. The short language they use can be called Acronym and Abbreviation.

Acronyms and Abbreviations are an element of language. Acronyms and abbreviations help people to shorten words that may be difficult to be understood. It often can be seen in letters, mail, etc. And now, we can see them on daily posts and comments on social media. For example, Daerah Khusus Ibukota can be abbreviated to DKI. However, an acronym is part of an abbreviation, which formed the initial component in a phrase or a word.

Acronyms and abbreviations that we found on Instagram can be as our material to be learned. When we found a new acronym or abbreviation, it means that we learn something new, and it can be interpreted in our daily communication on Social media or real life.

The writer decides to analyze acronyms and abbreviations on the daily post of Instagram because it can be a learning material for us, especially in English. It also can increase our vocabulary. Based on the description above, the writer is interested to conduct research entitled "Analysis of Acronym and Abbreviation in the Daily Post of Instagram".

2. Literature Riview

2.1 Acronym

According to Katamba (1994:126), words forming a complex expression referring to the name of an organisation, company or a scientific concept may be reduced to their initial letters alone which together represent sounds that form perfectly acceptable syllables and hence can be pronounced as words. It is called as acronym. Acronym is an otnography name of blending, which explained by Plag (2003:17) that acronym is coined by combining the initial letters of compounds or phrases into a pronouncable new word. Simple word abbreviation like NATO, USA, etc are the examples of acronym.

Acronym is not only coined by combine the initial letter into a pronouncable word, but also acronym may combine parts of different words, such as smog (smoke + fog) and modem (modulator + demodulator).

Acronym can be written with capital letters and lowercase letters. It depends on how it used. Capital letter interpreted to write a formal device. And the lowercase is used to write a regular device. But, some words are nowdays no spelt in capital letter, and some people are no longer related to the original words acronym. E.g. the word RADAR (Radio Detection and Ranging) is written in lowercase as *radar*.

Acronym, being a pronouncable word formation like a regular word, must fix to English Phonological pattern, which can create a problem when there are some illegal word pronounciation. But, for example, the word BBC is not a pronouncable word formation. But sometimes people make it pronouncable become *Bibici*.

2.2 Abbreviation

According to Plag (2003:161) abbreviation is process of taking initial letters of multiword sequences to make up a new word. Abbreviation has the same nature to blends, because both blend and abbreviation are amalgamations of parts of different words. Abbreviation has some types, which are:

2.2.1 Initialism

Plag (2003:163) stated that initialism is a part of abbreviation process that is pronounced in spelled. It can be either spelled in capital or in lower case letters, and they can be either pronounced by naming each individual letter. Lieber (53) stated that initialism process is pronounced as a series of letters. This process is taking the first letter to shorten the words. For examples:

- BA Bachelor of Arts
- DC District of Columbia
- EC European Community
- FAQ Frequently Asked Question

2.2.2Shortening

Shortening is an abbreviation which is ommited the beginning or the end of the word. For examples:

- Inc. Incorporated
- Norf. Norfolk
- Ont. Ontario

2.2.3 Contractions

Plag (2003:161) stated this abbreviation resembles blends by combining larger sets of initial and non-initial letters. For examples:

- kHz Kilohertz
- BSc Bachelor of Science
- Dr. Doctor
- Mr. Mister

2.2.4Acronimy

According to Lieber (53), acronym is part of abbreviation that is pronounced as a word, rather than as a series of letters. It is contrast with initialism. For example, Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndromegives (AIDS) can be pronounce as *eidz*. Cooperative for Assistance and Relief Everywhere (CARE) and Central Intelligence Agency (CIA).

1.3 Social Media Influencer

An influencer is a person who can influence people to do something because of his or her knowledge, position, and competence. However, a social media influencer is someone who can persuade others through social media, such as Instagram, Twitter, Facebook, etc. The standard of Instagram influencer are as follows:

- a. Nano-influencers: 1,000 10,000 followers.
- b. Micro-influencers: 10,000 50,000 followers.
- c. Mid-tier influencers: 50,000 500,000 followers.
- d. Macro-influencers: 500,000 1,000,000 followers.
- e. Mega-influencers: 1,000,000+ followers.

1.4 Instagram

Instagram is a free, online application to share photo, video, and social media platform that was acquired by Facebook in 2012. Instagram has four main features to post user activities on it. They are Instagram feeds, Instagram live, Instagram story, and Instagram TV.

3. Research Methodology

3.1 Participant/Subject

This research is qualitative analysis research which analyzes acronym and abbreviation in daily posts of random influencers Instagram accounts, posted from January until August 2020. They are Instagram influencers around the world with more than 100.000 followers. From those users, the posts are taken from their Feeds and Instastory posted from January until August 2020 that has Acronym and abbreviation. Therefore, the data of the research are collected by reading, finding, analyzing, listing, and classifying.

3.2 Instruments

The instrument of this study is some captions of a daily post of random influencers' Instagram accounts. They are influencers from around the world, which is posted from January until August 2020. The reference book that is used to analyze this study is an English book entitled Word-Formation in English, by Ingo Plag, 2003.

3.3 Data Analysis Procedures

In constructing data analysis, the writer does three steps concurrently. They are:

3.3.1 The writer selects words which contain acronym and abbreviation in the captions of daily post of random influencers Instagram accounts posted from January until August 2020.

- 3.3.2 The writer displays the data into descriptive data that is classified into acronym and abbreviation.
- 3.3.3 The writer decides the contribution in teaching Morphology.

4. Findings

 Acronym and Abbreviation Realization on Daily Posts of Random Influencer's Instagram Accounts Posted on January until August 2020

The researcher finds two kinds of acronym and three kinds of abbreviation from random influencer's Instagram accounts:

1.1.1 There are two kinds of acronym words. They are acronym with combining the initial letters and acronym with combining parts of different words. Those are written in capital letter and lowercase letter. The data will be showed as follows:

It shortens words from the first letter of each word, and it is readable. Ily, imy and LOX become the right examples for it. The acronyms listed here are written in the right context by the influencers. For example ily (i love you) with the sentence context "rp @alfredoflores **ily** / miss u" and lol (laughing out loud) with the sentence context "Grab the #Lathi merch make us rich **lol".**

Acronym with combining parts of different words is written by taking the main letters of the words to shorten it. In this study, it is only written in lowercase letter. For example brunch (breakfast and lunch). This acronym may be written in a context "I am going to live on the @vspink instagram page tomorrow at 1 PM EST/10AM PST to make some **brunch**".

1.1.2 There are 3 kinds of abbreviations, they are initialism, shortening, and contractions abbreviation. Each of them is devided into two subclasses, they are capital letter and lowercase letter.

The table above showed the data of initialism abbreviation. It takes the first letter to shorten the words. It is read as a series of letters. The researcher finds 2 kinds of initialism. They are capital letter abbreviation. The examples are YT for You Tube, HBD (Happy Birth Day), GRWM (Get Ready With Me), etc. Lowercase letter initialism, the examples from the list are hsm means high school musical and ilysm means i love you so much. However, each word listed above are written in the right context. For example, YT (You Tube). It is an online platform to upload, download, and watch videos. So, the sentence context is "New abs workout is up on **YT**", which the writer told that she has already uploaded her video to the You Tube. The next is OMG (Oh My God), which it expresses surprised and wonderful feeling. "Big announcement later today. So big. **OMG.** Huge". Another example from the list is MV (Music Video). It is an abbreviation of a special platform about video musical. The context was "10 million views on physical **MV**". Another example is Imao means *laughing my ass of.* The sentence context is **Imao**. How did we do?".

(Synchronize)* with the sentence context "I plan on making more of these lip**sync** tutorials...", *Pic. (Picture)* with the centence context "This is my current profile **pic**", and *Feb (February)* with the sentence context "#kidding S2 premieres **feb** 9". Those example are correct and suitable to the context.

There are two kinds of initialism found by researcher. They are capital letter abbreviation and lowercase abbreviation. The process of making contraction abbreviation is by taking some of the main letter of the word to be shortened. For example, smthn means *something*, Ig means *Instagram*, Bday means *Birthday*, Dr. Means *Doctor*, etc.

1.3 The Contribution of Analysis of Acronym and Abbreviation in Daily Post of Instagram for Teaching Morphology

This study deals with two kinds of word formation process, they are acronym and abbreviation, which word formation is Mophological subject. So, this study can contribute in teching Morphology for university level. The lecturer can make the lists of the acronym and abbreviation in this study as the example of kinds of word formation process. Students can search any caption in daily post of Instagram, and analyze the words that contain acronym and abbreviation. Then they can list them into acronym and abbreviation categories, and then analize the processes of making them, as what researcher did here. However, some words listed here is the updated words for nowdays, which took from the newest caption of Random Influencer's Instagram Posts posted on January until August 2020.

5. Discussion

The novelties of this study with the other studies are this study emphasizes the processes of making the kinds of acronym and abbreviation found in random influencer's daily post of Instagram, so that students could easily understand about how many kinds of acronym and abbreviation and how the processes of making the kinds of acronym and abbreviation. However, this study uses Instagram as the media of the research because Instagram becomes one of the largest social media application in the world, and there are so many students use Instagram nowdays. And this study takes the influencers as the subject because they have so many followers and they can influence people easily with the acronym and abbreviation in their daily caption of their posts.

6. Conclusion

There are two kinds of acronyms found in this study. They are acronym with combining the initial letters and acronym with **combining parts of different words**. Minewhile there are three kinds of abbreviation found in this study. They are initialism, shortening, and contraction abbreviation.

Acronym with combining the initial letters takes the first letter to shorten the words, and acronym with combining parts of different words combines the main letters of the words. Minewhile In abbreviation, initialism takes the first letter to shorten the words, shortening process ommits the beginning or the end of the words, and contraction process takes the main letters to shorten the words. However, they can be written in capital letter and lowercase letter. It depends on how people write and what people need.

This study is very relevant to be a source of material to teach morphology, because it is part of morphology.
