- d. Attitudes

At 00:45:57 the attitude shown between the boss and employees when working in this film is that the boss considers his employees like his own friends, it is not surprising that the boss's attitude to employees is relaxed and does not compare between superiors and subordinates.

- e. Artifact

At 00: 32:26 the artifact that can be observed in this film is the way the people who work at Stratton Oakmont dress up and also the logo of the company, they work by wearing their casual clothes according to comfort and showing who they are. Then the next artifact is related to the layout and also various office equipment at Stratton Oakmont.

4.2 National cultural dimensions

The writer use Hofstede's theory to find out the national cultural dimensions in the movie. The national cultural dimensions are

a. Power Distance

The power distance based on the film is that there is no difference in the treatment of a boss to his employees or employees to his boss at work. They work just like working with their friends regardless of whether he is a subordinate or a boss in an office. The power distance on the movie is low because it not pays too much attention to position levels.

b. Individualism vs. Collectivism

Individual freedom and someone's privacy are very much appreciated, it looks like in this movie which shows Jordan Belfort who thinks about his own life above others, he will focus on his work and not take care of what is not his business.

c. Masculinity vs. Feminity

Women, and men work side by side. It can be seen when Jordan Belfort as a boss in the office works with each other with his employees in a room in the office and there is no difference whether they are different levels as a boss, manager, or just an ordinary employee.

d. Uncertainty Avoidance

Western culture in the work ethic will free everyone and generations to go and work for adventure. As in this film, it is clear if there is a person's freedom to work like Jordan Belfort. Jordan Belfort always has potential whatever he is working on. Jordan will do anything to achieve his goals. He has various ways to achieve his wish.

4.3 The contribution to Cross-Cultural Understanding Teaching

In this film, the visible artifact is the way people dress in the office and also the company logo. As westerners when working in the office, they wear casual clothes and the most important thing is to make them comfortable. The company logo inside the company which depict a lion with the words "Stratton Oakmen, Inc." also becomes an artifact.

Hofstede's theory is used to analyze the national cultural dimensions contained in *The Wolf of Wall Street* movie. The following are the results of the analysis that the author has found.

1) Power Distance

The power distance in this movie is low. There is no difference in power, position, or position of a person when interacting with others. They actually work as their own friends without having to worry about who we talk to and what to behave.

2) Individualism vs Collectivism

Individual freedom contained in the film is highly respected because everyone has their own freedom when they want to do something or achieve something they want. So individual freedom in the film is very high and appreciated.

3) Masculinity vs Femininity

Masculinity and femininity contained in this film are that they work side by side with each other in an office, so there is no barrier to where the table position is where he has to work in a company. Then for the men in the problem of Masculinity is very dominating, because the store in that is Jordan Belfort, who is a man who leads a company and has many roles in it.

4) Uncertainty Avoidance

The freedom to work and explore in the film is highly respected because everything that Jordan Belfort and his employees do is given full freedom to do something or freedom when they want to achieve something, so there is no such thing as a prohibition or anything that gets in the way.

6. Conclusion
